WATERSPORTS

ON WATER ASSISTANT: If you have experience in sailing, kayaking or windsurfing, you can come help us **on water.** We are always in need of competent helms and powerboat drivers to help us throughout the year, especially during our busy months from March to October. You can also sign up to help us at one of our activities – Frostbite Series, Twilight Sailing or Open Sessions.

ON LAND ASSISTANT: Even if you don't have any prior experience, you can still help us with **on land** activities such as helping out with life jackets, assisting our watersports staff to get along with day-to-day activities and during events.
